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### Materials You'll Need

- Worsted weight yarn (we recommend using a soft, warm yarn such as wool or alpaca)
- Knitting needles in the size recommended on the yarn label
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

### Abbreviations

- CO - cast on
- K - knit
- P - purl
- BO - bind off
- St(s) - stitch(es)

## **Wrist Warmers**

Wrist warmers are a great way to keep your hands warm and cozy without having to wear bulky gloves. They're also a quick and easy project to knit, making them a great choice for beginners.

## **Materials**

- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn
- Knitting needles in size US 7 (4.5mm)

## **Instructions**

1. CO 24 sts.
2. K all rows until the wrist warmers measure 6 inches from the cast-on edge.
3. BO all sts.

To finish, fold the wrist warmers in half and sew the ends together.

## **Hat**

A warm and cozy hat is essential for any winter wardrobe. This simple hat is easy to knit and can be customized to fit any head size.

## **Materials**

- 2 skeins of worsted weight yarn
- Knitting needles in size US 8 (5mm)

## **Instructions**

1. CO 120 sts.
2. K all rows until the hat measures 8 inches from the cast-on edge.
3. K2tog around.
4. K1, K2tog around.
5. Repeat step 4 until there are only 6 sts remaining.
6. Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining sts.

To finish, fold the hat in half and sew the sides together.

## **Neck Warmer**

A neck warmer is a great way to keep your neck and chest warm on cold days. This simple neck warmer is easy to knit and can be customized to any length.

## **Materials**

- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn
- Knitting needles in size US 9 (5.5mm)

## Instructions

1. CO 60 sts.
2. K all rows until the neck warmer measures 24 inches from the cast-on edge.
3. BO all sts.

To finish, fold the neck warmer in half and sew the ends together.
